10 million Euros for research on waste water management in Tra Noc industrial zone, Can Tho

(baodautu.vn) On September 6th, the project management board of strategy for integrated waste water management concept in Industrial zones (AKIZ) did hold a Workshop on "Cost calculation, cost transparency and investment financing for waste water management at industrial zones and urban regions".

The Workshop provided for companies on building industrial zones infrastructures, enterprises who want to make investment plan as basis for alloting capital, technical requirements, legal frameworks, table of fee for waste water treatment services so as to make sure the effectiveness and sustainable operation the whole waste water treatment.

Through pilot treatments in containers in different industries inside Tra Noc industrial zones, Can Tho, hi-tech solutions in pre-treatment of waste water, energy recovery, and regeneration of valuable substances will be considered and appropriately adjusted to the local conditions. Appropriate technologies and solutions in sludge management, surveying for environmental monitoring will create the data base for controlling mechanisms, esp to toxicity-containing waste water.

AKIZ project is collaboratively co-operated by Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST) of Viet Nam and Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) of Germany, along with German industrial partners. Total budget for the project is more than 10 million Euros.

The project is implemented in the period from 2010-2014, including basic and conceptual studies, set up and adaption, optimization and evaluation, verification and transfer.
